Program Notes:

Shine

Shine is a song about love, unity, and hope. This piece features six soloists from the Maestros as well as a beautiful chorus sung by the whole choir that comes back throughout the piece. Shine teaches us that even in the most difficult times, coming together and working with others can make a positive difference.

Cantar!

With the flair of Cuban salsa music, exciting rhythms, and a catchy melody, *Cantar!* ("Sing!") will make you want to move. Sung in Spanish, the refrain translates to "Sing a joyful song".

When I Close My Eyes

Jim Papoulis is known for writing songs with messages of hope, inspiration, and lyrical melodies. When I Close My Eyes is a beautiful reminder to believe in oneself even when things are difficult.

Let's Call the Whole Thing Off

This jazz song was written for the 1937 film "Shall We Dance" in which Fred Astaire and Ginger Rogers sing while dancing on roller skates. It is most well-known for its different pronunciations, such as po-tay-to/po-tah-to and to-may-to/to-mah-to. This is meant to reflect the different social classes in America at the time. Those in the upper-class preferred more of a refined "ah" sound to distinguish them from the lower-class.

Come, Travel With Me

The men of VocalPoint present this beautiful piece by contemporary composer Scott Farthing with text inspired by Walt Whitman's "Song of the Open Road."

Children, Go Where I Send Thee

Children, Go Where I Send Thee is a traditional African American Spiritual popularized in the 1930s by the Golden Gate Quartet. The lead singer of this group, Willie T. Johnson, was the father of the arranger of this version, Kevin Phillip Johnson. As his father did before, the son uses rhythm in exciting new ways and a rap section to continue the evolution of this folk tune.

The Road Home

Stephen Paulus presents this arrangement of the traditional hymn tune "Prospect" published in 1835 in *Southern Harmony* with new text composed specifically for the composer.

Oye

Jim Papoulis works with *The Foundation for Small Voices* to conduct songwriting workshops for children around the world. While working with students in Mexico, he asked them if they had a message they wished to convey to the world. Their message became the song they wrote together: Oye-"to listen" or "to listen up". In Papoulis' words "When I hear this song performed, I am suddenly transported back to the streets where these children walk, go to school, live, and dream—they dream that somehow, somewhere, their small voices will be heard."
