1st ANNUAL CHICAGO NATIONAL CHAMBER MUSIC COMPETITION

Midwest Young Artists (MYA, 878 Lyster Road, Highwood, IL) is pleased to announce the inaugural year of its **Chicago National Chamber Music Competition** to be held on Sunday, February 17, 2008 at the **Skokie Theatre Foundation** (7924 N. Lincoln Ave., Skokie, IL).

Over the past 15 years MYA has proven itself as the premiere youth chamber ensemble organization in the United States as evidenced by success in competitions, size of programs, and services offered. The competition is open to all instruments and is divided into the following two categories: Strings & Piano and All Other Instruments (brass, percussion, voice, winds). Applicants must register on-line at www.mya.org by midnight on **January 18, 2008.**Contestants will be competing for **over \$5,000** in **cash prizes and scholarships** and the winner of each division will perform in a Winners Recital at the Chicago Cultural Center on Sunday, April 20, 2008.
