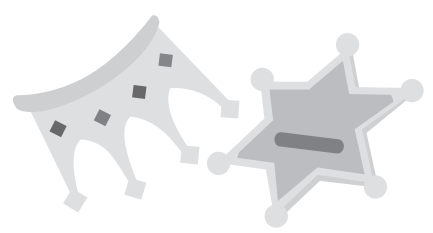

Applications submitted on or before **March 1, 2006** will have the \$50 non-refundable application fee waived. Post deadline, applicants are admitted on a rolling basis if there are openings. All applications for financial aid must be in the MYA office by **March 1, 2006**.
