- NOTE: Students who participated in 2012 CCMW and MYA Concert and Symphony Orchestra students do not need to send an audition recording.
- NOTE: Students can upload their audition to YouTube or a website for review.

Selection is made using Rolling Admissions until all spots are filled with **Priority** given to those applying **before March 15, 2013**.

Tuition and Fees:

\$50 Application Fee is <u>non-refundable</u> and *applied toward Workshop tuition*, if accepted.

\$3,200 Residential

\$2,800 Non-Residential (no housing or meals)

\$1,000 - Due once notified of acceptance (applied towards tuition)
