Saturday, July 12

9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.: Private lessons with Jim Walker for MYA Flute workshop students only

1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.: Technique/improvisation class for all students

3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.: Master class (20 minutes per student, 9 student maximum)

Private lessons with Jim Walker for MYA Flute workshop students only. *Students are responsible for the lesson fees.*

Eligibility

The Jim Walker Residency at Midwest Young Artists is open to high school and university students, as well as professional level musicians in grades 9 and above as of Fall 2014.

\$30 Non-refundable application fee (*this fee is applied toward the \$150 performer fee, if accepted*)

\$60 Auditors

**Tuition for the Jim Walker Residency at Midwest Young Artists is waived for registrants of the 2014 MYA Flute Workshop.*

Jim Walker is the Professor of Practice and Coordinator of Flute Studies at the University of Southern California's Thornton School of Music as well as the Instructor of Flute, Chamber Music and Technology at the Colburn Conservatory of Music. Formerly the Principal Flute of the Los Angeles Philharmonic, Mr. Walker is an expert in all genres including classical and jazz.

Audition Information *(for master class performers only)*

All audition materials and payments must be received by **June 1**.

Please send an audition DVD with \$30 application fee to Jeremy Krifka at 878 Lyster Road, Highwood, IL 60040, OR email a link to an audition video recording (YouTube, etc.) to jeremykrifka@mya.org, and either mail the \$30 application fee or pay online at mya.org

Audition videos do not need to be professionally done. Accompanied audition videos are suggested, but are not required.

Required audition materials:

- One major work/movement from the standard flute repertoire.
- The audition video must be no longer than 10 min. You are allowed to make cuts to the work if it exceed the 10 minute limit.
- The piece that is used for the audition must be the piece that will be performed on the master class, if accepted.
